**Quinta de La Rosa 20 YO Tawny Port, Tempranillo, Douro, Portugal** 7.00  
 The beautiful golden colour is a good indication of the age of this  
 excellent tawny port. With a great richness and aromatic complexity, notably  
 of almond and spices, the 20 year old has a seductive texture with dry  
 fruits and liqueur flavours.

**Quinta de La Rosa LBV Port Tempranillo, Douro, Portugal 2013** 7.50  
 This LBV has a good, clean defined style similar to other La Rosa ports with  
 a good structure, integrated, mature tannins and soft wood undertones. La  
 Rosa ports are always slightly drier than most, and the brandy is always  
 well integrated. Great Complexity and length. Sweet, alcoholic and full  
 bodied! Great all round red for a cheeseboard. Fruit and intensity to match  
 almost any style.

**Quinta de La Rosa White Extra Dry Port** 7.50  
 Quinta de la Rosa's White Port is made in the traditional manner in our  
 granite lagares, the grapes are lightly trodden to give its distinctive  
 golden colour. A beautiful amber/honey colour, it shows excellent fruit on  
 the palate, tropical fruits especially pineapple, but at the same time has a  
 long dry finish, typical of the house style you find at La Rosa. Grape  
 Varieties include Gouveio, abigato, Malvasia Fina.

**The Rookery Mead, Craft Mead from Perthshire, Scotland** 6.50  
 Mead is likely to be the oldest alcoholic drink in the world with  
 archaeological evidence suggesting mead production in Western Turkey in  
 45,000 BCE. Mead is an alcoholic drink made from honey, usually fermented.  
 Nose is Floral, honey, tangy. Smooth, sherry-like and with a hint of musk.  
 Initial mouth sweetness followed and a strong, alcohol warmth. Lingers with  
 floral notes from the heather honey. Great accompaniment to cheese.
